Sub: NULM & MEPMA - Aadhar seeding and Updation of progress into NULM & MEPMA Portal by 30.04.2018 – Certain instructions issued – reg.

I invite your attention to the reference cited. You are aware that the Government of India is implementing the National Urban Livelihood Mission with primary objective of reducing the poverty and vulnerability of Urban Poor households through State Urban Livelihood Mission (SULM) of concerned State. Under the Self-Employment Programme component of the Mission, financial assistance is provided to beneficiaries by way of interest subvention on bank loans, for interest rate over and above 7% charged by the banks.

The Ministry has entered into a MoU with Allahabad Bank for design and development of web portal for streaming the process of releasing interest subvention to the beneficiaries under SEP. As per the proposed system, the Interest Subvention claims will be uploaded centrally by the banks in the portal. The beneficiary data for reimbursement of Interest Subvention claims submitted by banks will then be verified by the Urban Local Bodies (ULBs). After verification by the ULBs, the data will be approved by the Mission Director and the subvention amount will transferred on Direct Beneficiary Transfer (DBT) mode to beneficiary.

Vide reference 2nd cited, the Joint Secretary to the ministry of Housing & Urban Affairs informed that DAY-NULM is rating the performance of the States on implementation of all components of scheme through Systematic Progressive Analytical Real Time Ranking (SPARK). This is based on the real time performance of all components and indicators are fixed for scaling the performance of each component. Out of the parameters fixed by the GoI, the Aadhar Seeding also one of the indicators, which are having 30 marks out of total 100 marks.

Hence, it is decided that the funds under DAY-NULM and other State schemes being implemented by this office will be released to the beneficiary after completion of Aadhar seeding under various components.

In view of the above, the Project Directors and Addl. Commissioner.UCD, GHMC are requested to complete the data entry by April 30th in special drive mode in all ULBs. The following data is to be uploaded in both NULM & MEPMA portal.

- Aadhar seeding of all the SHGs and all the components.
- Bank Linkage progress from 2014 to till date.
- SEP-I & G loan disbursed details from 2014 to till date.
- MUDRA loans
- Interest Subvention releases details in NULM portal.
- EDP trainings for SEP & MUDRA beneficiaries.
- SEP & MUDRA Repayment details in MEPMA portal.

Therefore, all the Project Directors are directed to ensure updation in both NULM & MEPMA portal by April 30th, 2018. If any CO / TMC / TPrO /DMC fail to update and not complete this assignment before the said date, initiate disciplinary action against those employees.
