Soil Transmitted Helminthes (STH), also called parasitic worms is a significant public health concern in India. Evidence shows detrimental impact of STH infestation on Physical Growth , Anemia, under nutrition and cognitive development as well as poor attendance at school. Considering the prevalence of STH infections in Telangana is high 60%, it is crucial for the NDD Programme to reach all children aged 1 -19Years consistently over each NDD round. In the August 19 round NDD showed coverage of 3745098 (93%) children between the age group of 1-19 from (15) NDD implemented districts.

In this regard, the Additional Commissioner UCD GHMC ,the Project Director, MEPMA are directed to coordinate with the Health department and conduct special SLF/MAS meetings and TLF meetings on the specific steps to strengthen the coordination among the Anganwadi centers , and concern line departments for the mobilization of the children of 1 to 19 years age group for the NDD Programme on 10.02.2020 and mop-up day on 17.02.2020. and also it is directed to identify the Vulnerable areas for coverage of drop out school children and submit the report in the prescribed format .
