I invite your kind attention subject to the reference cited above, as you are aware that shelter for Urban Homeless (SUH) is under implementation as a component of Deendayal Antyodaya Yojana- National Urban Livelihoods Mission (DAY- NULM), which is a centrally sponsored scheme. The funds for SUH are provided not only for construction and refurbishment of shelters but also for their operation and management (O & M).

It would be appreciated that construction and operation of shelters is quite capital intensive considering this aspect, the operational Guidelines of SUH provided that States/UTs may also construct shelters with Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) support and other donations. If required the name of the corporate/donor can be displayed on the shelter.

Further, the Central Government is providing fund for O & M cost for shelters for the period of first 5 Years of operation and thereafter, State/UTs have to evolve plan for self-sustainability of shelters. For this, external support would be of immense help in their sustainability.

where in the GOI ,Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs are requested the Ministry of Corporate Affairs to add 'support to Shelters for Urban Homeless' in Schedule VII of Companies Act, 2013 since this Schedule specifies the activities that qualify under CSR and an explicit mention of support for Shelters for Urban Homeless' in this Schedule

may help in enlisting support by the Corporate adequately.

Accordingly Ministry of Corporate Affairs has informed as under : Item no. (iii) of schedule VII inter alia includes, " measures for reducing inequalities faced by socially and economically backward groups". The item enclosed in Schedule VII are broad based and intended to cover a wide range of activities. General Circular dated 18.06.2014 clarifies that Schedule VII entries be interpreted liberally to capture the essence of the subjects enumerated therein. As per the Act, it is the prerogative of the Board to select the CSR activities to be undertaken.

Hence the Addl. Commissioner, UCD, GHMC and all the Project Directors of DAY NULM Shelters are requested to take appropriate action at the GHMC and concern Urban Local Body level to approach the corporates and get Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) support for Shelters to make them self-sustainable and submit the report on CSR in the prescribed format by March 2020.
