2. The Mission Director, MEPMA has briefed about the Status of Survey of Street Vendors, progress made under PM SVANidhi and Bank wise pendency for sanction of loans. The details are as follows:

- No. of Street Vendors identified as on 10.06.2020 : 83,666
- No. of Street Vendors identified during Quick survey from 11.06.2020 : 1,10,361 (131.91 % increase)
- Cumulative no. of Street Vendors identified : 1,94,027 (1.33% of total population)
- No. of applications uploaded in PMSVANidhi portal: 51,186
- No. of loans sanctioned : 4,794
- Amount of linkage : 4,79,40,000/-

The following points were discussed and approved during the meeting for action:

- To complete the quick survey of street vendors which is under progress in ULBs.
- To speedup uploading of loan applications for all the identified eligible Street vendors in PMSVANidhi portal and facilitate in sanction and release of loans under PMSVANidhi Scheme.
- The SLBC is requested to coordinate with bankers for sanctioning and release of loans as per the applications received and also to pick up the applications from the market place based on the location of Street Vendor and sanction and release the loans accordingly.
- All Municipal Commissioners should issue letter to the bankers for release of loans to Street Vendors based on the Identity Card or Vending Certificate issued by the ULB as they are as per criteria.
- MD, Streenidhi has assured that, Streenidhi will sanction and release loans to all the Street Vendors who are in Women SHGs and who have paid share capital and requested to mark to Streenidhi as preferred lender while uploading the applications.
- There should not be any target /upper limit for any bank / branch for release of loans under PMSVANidhi. All the applications marked to the banks need to be sanctioned by the banks / branches.
