Sub: MEPMA -Telanganaku Harithaharam 2021 - Development of Homestead Nurseries by SHGs in Municipalities – certain instructions – Issued –Reg.

Ref: Circular, No. MEPMA-TKHH/NSRS/1/2018, Dated: 19.06.2020 by Mission Director, MEPMA.

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The attention of the Municipal Commissioners in the State is invited to the reference cited wherein instructions were issued regarding preparatory work of nursery raising for taking up of Pattana Haritha Haram which is a Flagship Programme of the State.

The Municipal Commissioners are directed to follow the instructions given below for developing homestead nurseries in the ULBs:

1. The Municipal Commissioners are directed to encourage SHGs/SLFs/TLFs for raising of homestead plants in the land/space available in the premises of their houses in the 4x7 and 5x9 bags in the month of January/February.
2. The healthy plants shall be purchased by the Municipal Commissioners @10/- per each duly following due procedures (Maintaining stock register, Distribution format with signatures, documentation with photographs etc). The plants purchased from the SHGs shall be distributed to households in TKHH 2021 from July onwards.
3. During the months of August to December, homestead nurseries shall be used for raising convertible species in the 4x7 and 5x9 bags by the SHGs. ULB

shall procure the suitable plants @ Rs. 10/- per plant for conversion into bigger bags. The plants so procured shall be converted into the bigger bags for avenue plantation in the ULB nurseries by the ULB concerned.

4. If the space is not available, the Municipal Commissioner should allot available space/parks to SHGs/ALFs/TLFs with proper fencing and water supply for establishing Homestead nurseries.

5. The SHGs/ALFs/TLFs shall bear the cost of the seedlings and take care of the plant until it grows to minimum 2 feet height. It shall be the responsibility of the SHGs/ALFs/TLFs for nurturing the Plant.

6. Required support may be provided in procuring soil and compost to the SHG members for the development of nurseries.

7. An agreement may be entered by the Municipal Commissioner concerned and work order may be issued to the selected SHG/ALF/TLF.

8. The amount payable to the SHG member shall be directly transferred to the bank account of the SHG member/SHGs/ALFs/TLFs.

The following general species (indicative) may be raised in the nurseries, along with other choiceable species as per the public demand.

Further, the Municipal Commissioners are instructed to clear the pending payments of plants received from the Homestead Nurseries raised by the SHGs/ALFs/TLFs in the year 2019-20 @Rs. 10/- per plant immediately from the available funds and submit Action Taken Report by 25.11.2020.
