Sub: MEPMA – Advise Branches for sanction of Bank Linkage to Self Help Groups (SHGs) – Regarding.

You are aware that the implementation of Government Schemes on Poverty Alleviation is an ongoing process and we cannot stop them on the ground of NPAs.

On our part, we are also giving utmost importance to the recoveries of the loans taken by the SHG members. Accordingly, we also instructed our staff to review the progress of the same regularly.

It came to our notice that most of the Branches of your Banks are not coming forward in processing of fresh loans to the SHGs and financial assistance to the beneficiaries of Self Employment Programme. The Banks are avoiding such proposals till the old accounts are regularized.

Please agree to the concern of the State and Central Governments in implementation of above initiatives under various schemes and their priority and also Social obligation on the part of Public Sector Banks.

Therefore, you are requested to instruct the Branches under your control not to stop the Financial Linkage on the ground of recovery and also instruct them to attend Community Based Recovery Mechanism (CBRM)/ Slum Level Federation (SLF)/ Town Level Federation (TLF) and Town Level Bankers Committee (TLBC) Meetings conducted every month by the concerned Urban Local Bodies (ULBs) for recovery of old dues.

We assure our cooperation in this regard.
