Minutes of the Review Meeting with District Mission Coordinators held by the Mission Director, MEPMA on 22.01.2019 on all activities of MEPMA

Participants:

- 1. Addl. Mission Director, MEPMA
- 2. All State Mission Coordinators of MEPMA
- 3. Skill Training Partners (Health Sector)

The Mission Director reviewed the strategy followed by the Skill Training Partners and District Mission Coordinator for the Health Sector (Arogyadhooth) and reviewed the progress of all the components of DAY-NULM and the preparedness for Shehari Samrudhi Utsav (Pakhwada) and given certain instructions.

- The Mission Director opined that the candidates mobilized for the skill trainings under Employment through Skills Training & Placement programme are not with the suitable aptitude and further observed that the involvement of SHG members is not being done in mobilization.
- Further, it is observed that, there is no coordination between DPMU/ULB staff of MEPMA and the Skill Training Partners in mobilization of suitable candidates to the various training programmes.
- Right person for the right course has to be identified.

<u>Mobilization of candidates to Aarogya Dhooth & Other Health</u> Sector Courses:

- Aarogya Dhooth programme is introduced in convergence with National Urban Health Mission (NUHM) to improve Infant Mortality Rate (IMR) & Maternal Mortality Ratio (MMR) of Telangana State and for providing bedside assistance to elderly and patients at their residence.
- Candidates with suitable aptitude to be mobilized, so that they will sustain in the that sector.
- Proper orientation to be given to the candidates regarding the course in which they are going to be trained and employment opportunities during the mobilization.
- A ULB wise Mobilization Calendar has been prepared for organizing Mobilization Camps for unemployed youth for all heath sector courses on fixed dates i.e 1st Saturday and 2nd Friday of every

month. The ULB wise mobilization calendar is appended to this minutes.

- All the Skill Training Partners who are providing health related trainings in that ULBs must attend the Mobilization Camps without fail.
- The MCs of concerned ULBs are instructed to organize the mobilization camps in coordination with the Skill Training Partners, SHGs/SLFs/ TLFs.

OLA Job Melas

- OLA is conducting Job Melas in Hyderabad and surrounding ULBs to identify the OLA Bike riders.
- The interested candidates who are having driving license and willing to migrate to Hyderabad are to be identified from all the ULBs.
