Sub : MEPMA- NUHM-National wide Polio Vaccination Campaign on 3<sup>rd</sup> March 2024 –Mobilization of children age group 0-5 years –Booths/mobile teams in the slum areas – by SHGS/SLFs./TLFs – instructions –reg

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The attention of all the Municipal Commissioners and the Project Directors MEPMA in the state are invited to the reference cited ,Wherein as per the Govt. of India directives one round of Pulse Polio Immunization (PPI) campaign will be conducted across the state on 03.03.2024 with 2 drops of bivalent Oral Polio Vaccine (bOPV) will be administered to all the children in the age group of 0-5 years including newborns.

2 The Pulse Polio Immunization Program (PPI) will be conducted in the state on 3<sup>rd</sup> March 2024 as per GOI guidelines. The program will be conducted as booth day activity on 3<sup>rd</sup> March (constituting the polio booths) followed by House-to-House activity for three days from 4<sup>th</sup>- 6<sup>th</sup> March 2024. 4<sup>th</sup> day activity (7<sup>th</sup> March 2024) will be conducted in Municipal Corporation areas due to vast population in Hyderabad. Transit booths will be established at Bus stops, Railway Stations who shall administer bOPV for travelling children.

3. For effective and successful conduct of the Pulse Polio program in all the ULBs including GHMC area , it is requested to follow the PPI activities with MEPMA Staff by involving SHG federations of SLFs/TLFs .The details as follows

1. To conduct special mother's meetings in the urban slums on pulse polio immunization.
2. To ensure active participation of MEPMA District & ULB staff and members of the self help groups (SHGs) for mobilization of beneficiaries at booth and House to house activity.
3. Supervision by MEMPA coordinators in their respective area.

4. Community Mobilization
5. Create Awareness in the community
6. To include PPI and Immunization program into their SHG meeting agenda.
7. To identify the vulnerable locations and conduct the special drive for PPI
8. To conduct the sample survey in 50 to 100 HH with SLF RPs on 100 % coverage of the PPI by 7<sup>th</sup> March 2024 in vulnerable areas of the ULB.

4. Therefore all the Municipal Commissioners and all the Project Directors/DMCs are hereby instructed to follow the guidelines **on Pulse Polio Immunization (PPI) on Date 3.03.2024** ( Sunday) for mobilization of the children for age group of 0-5 years through SHG network and to facilitate for the mobile teams to reach the uncovered areas for PPI .
