Sub:- MEPMA – DAY-NULM – Support to Urban Street Vendors – PM Street Vendor’s AtmaNirbhar Nidhi, a Special Micro Credit Facility Scheme to Street Vendors – Completion of all Sanctions, Disbursement of loans, Digital on-boarding of Street Vendors and Training as waiver of stamp duty on loans accorded by Govt is ending by Oct 31st October, 2020 and increased sales in view of Dasara festival – Organizing Camps - Release of Funds – Orders issued - Regarding.

ORDER:

Through the references cited, it is informed that digital on boarding of Street Vendors is an integral and important part for facilitating and promoting them to undertake credit as well as debit transactions on digital platform with ease. Further, informed that during the webinar held on 11.09.2020 jointly by Joint Secretary, DFS and Joint Secretary MoHUA with the banks and SIDBI, the banks have agreed for handholding and training of Street Vendors in undertaking digital transactions and also promoting debit transactions through payment Apps/ BHIM UPI App. All the Banks were also informed of the following activities to be undertaken within one week of the disbursement of the loan:

- i. To generate a UPI ID for the beneficiary at the time of disbursement of Loan.
- ii. Arrange for issue of a Durable QR Code containing the UPI ID.
- iii. To issue RuPay debit card.
- iv. Train Street Vendors (SVs) on the use of QR code and their payment App /BHIM UPI

App for conducting digital transactions at the place of their business, by utilizing the services of Banking Business correspondents/ hired field Functionaries.

- v. Make SVs under take the ‘penny drop’ transactions for both the process – credit & debit, to create evidence for handholding.

2. Further, as waiver of Stamp Duty on Loans to Street Vendors accorded by Telangana Govt is going to be closed by October 31st and inview of Dasara Festival, it is decided to organize Camps for sanctioning of all loans of street vendors , disbursement, onboarding and conducting training to SVs for digital transactions. Further during the meeting some of the major banks like SBI, UBI have informed that they have a provision to generate the UPI IDs and issue QR codes to Street Vendors in their banks. The remaining banks like APGVB, TGB, DCCB etc., have requested MEPMA for providing support for generation of UPI IDs.

5. Further, as per the willingness of Bankers, utilise stamp duty accorded by the Govt, camps on following dates required be organized twice in a week in all ULBs on the following dates for completing all Sanctions, Disbursement of loans to Street Vendors, Issue of UPI IDs and QR Codes and training on Digital Transactions to Street Vendors.

6. An amount of Rs. 6,000/- (Rupees Six Thousand Only) is hereby sanctioned for conducting each camp in each ULB towards Logistic Arrangements (Chairs, Tables, Audio Video System, Banners, Tent (if required), etc), Drinking water, Tea and Snacks to Bankers, Payment aggregators, Trainers, other officials, Hand Sanitizers, Stationary items etc.. Any additional amount is necessitated, the same may be met from General Funds/Pattana Pragathi grants (state matching share).

7. The Municipal Commissioners are instructed to organize the camps and mobilize all the Street Vendors to the camps (No. of Street vendors to be mobilized in each camp should be decided based on the total no. of the street vendors applied for PMSVANidhi in the ULB) and also ensure presence of Branch Managers of all Banks, RM/ Managers/ Asst Managers of Streenidhi and representatives of digital payment aggregators like Pay Swiff, Phone Pay, Paytm, Airtel Payment Bank etc for taking up the following activities in the camps duly following the COVID-19 Protocol:

- a. Coordinate with bankers for sanction and disbursement of all the pending applications under PMSVANidhi and update in Udyamimitra Portal.
- b. To coordinate with Bankers and Digital payment Aggregators for generation of UPI IDs and issue of digital QR Codes to Street Vendors in the camps.
- c. All the Street vendors who have been sanctioned loans should be trained in digital transactions by using QR code and payment App/ BHIM UPI App and financial literacy by utilizing the services of local bank branches and Digital Payment

aggregators.

- d. Issue of RuPay debit card to the Street Vendors who don't have ATM card.
- e. Make the Street Vendors to undertake the penny drop transactions for both the processes – Credit & Debit, to create evidence for handholding.

8. Hence sanction is hereby accorded for an amount of Rs. 43,80,000.00 (Rupees Forty Three Lakhs Eighty Thousand Only) for conducting 5 camps in each ULB and 5 camps in each Zone of GHMC.

9. Accordingly, the Finance Manager, MEPMA is hereby requested to release an amount of

Rs. 43,80,000.00 (Rupees Forty Three Lakhs Eighty Thousand Only) to the Project Directors, MEPMA as per the above statement through e transfer to respective districts from the available funds under NULM funds.

10. Further, the Project Directors or PD/DMC, MEPMA are directed to release the funds to the concerned Municipal Commissioners towards conduct of Camps for Sanction, Disbursement of loans, Digital on-boarding of Street Vendors and Training on digital transactions and submit the Utilization Certificate to the under signed.

11. Hence, the Commissioner, GHMC, CEO, Secunderabad Cantonment Board and the Municipal Commissioners of all ULBs are requested to organize the camps on the above said dates and ensure sanction, disbursement of all loans, Digital on-boarding and training of all Street Vendors for whom loans are sanctioned under PMSVANidhi Scheme keeping in view of exemption of stamp duty till 31.10.2020 only.
