



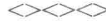

Sub:- STEP-UP/RYSK- Amendment to MoA about the revised payment of Training fee to the empanelled training partners for the year 2013-14 with effect from 01-10-2013- Implement the amendment- Requested- Regarding.



REEMAP has requested to make common proceedings and payment structure in all the sub-missions under RYSK.

The matter was placed before the Executive Committee and the E.C. has approved to make payments @ 25%, 50%, 25% for entire training duration to all the courses undertaken by the training partner empanelled through RFP for MEPMA.

The details of payments and revised payment structure have been given in the Annexure for ready reference. Required changes in the software have already been made by CGG.

Therefore all the Project Directors of DPMUs and Project Officers of Mission Cities are requested to follow the payment structure for the batches commenced from 01-10-2013 in your district.
