In the reference 1st cited, this office has communicated District wise and ULB wise targets along with timelines for Self Employment Programme (SEP) and SHG-Bank Linkage (BL) components for the year 2020-21.

The Mission Director, MEPMA reviewed the progress of Self Employment Programme and Bank Linkage through teleconference and felt dissatisfaction on the performance of DMCs.

The following districts are much lagging behind i.e., below 40% in achieving the targets of Self Employment Programme (SEP), Bank Linkage (BL) even after lapse of 7 months inspite of continuous follow up as detailed below:

SEP poor progress Districts:

Vikarabad (2.04%), Jangoan (5.00%), Hyderabad (6.15%), Narayanapet (6.67%),

Peddapalli (7.94%), Adilabad (12.00%), Warangal Rural (15.79%),

Medchal-Malkajgiri (18.60%), Rangareddy(18.99%), Mancherial (23.77%),

Wanaparthy (25.00%), Yadadri-Bhongir (25.56%), Gadwal (25.93%),

Siddipet (27.40%) and Medak (32.35%)

SHG-Bank Linkage poor progress districts:

GHMC (26.25%), Yadadri-Bhongir (27.08%) and Rangareddy (38.75%)

From the above, it is evident that the performance of District Mission Coordinators is not up to the mark in achieving the targets.

In view of the above, all the Project Directors of MEPMA in the State and the Addl. Commissioner, UCD, GHMC are instructed to ensure 60% achievement of targets of Self Employment Programme (SEP) and Bank Linkage (BL) for the year 2020-21 by the end of January 2020 and 100% by the end of March 2021.

Further, the above poor performing DMCs are directed to submit explanation for their poor performance within a week. Any slackness in this matter will be viewed very seriously and disciplinary action will be initiated against them whose performance is poor.
