

EST&P- Identification and Registration of unemployed youth - involvement of SHGs, SLFs, TLFs & CLCs- Targets for each DMCs, ADMCs, TMCs and COs-

Read: EST&P Targets for the year 2017-18.

Please read subject and reference cited; the ULB wise targets are already communicated to all the DPMUs dated 24-06-2017 and in this regard you are directed to identify the eligible unemployed youth between the age group of 18-35 and register them in the prescribed application format.

You are requested to allocate targets to each DMC, ADMC, TMC and Community Organiser and make sure that the beneficiaries to be identified and registered, at least 3 times more than the target allotted to each ULB of your district. The DMC of the district should be responsible for achieving the target with the field team.

As per the guidelines of the component a minimum of 50% registered candidates should be from the families of SHGs in a batch and there should not be any deviation from this mandate. Also assure that, there are proportionate registration of the candidates from SCs, STs, Minorities, PWDs and women as per existing reservation.

DMCs and TMCs would be held responsible if targeted numbers of candidates from the required categories have not done and the mobilisation should start immediately. The list of selected candidates submitted to this office by 31st July, 2017.

For each candidate registered and join the programme, the SHG/RP/CLC would get the remuneration of Rs.100/- and after another Rs.100/- would get after completion of the training of the candidate in order to maintain retention in the training. These amounts would be given by the Skill Training Providers to whom the candidates have been mapped for their batches.

Identification to be done through the following activities:

- 1. All the employees of the DPMU and ULB should inform the SHGs and their federation about the proposed courses in the ULB by participating in their meetings,
- 2. Press notes to be released regularly.
- 3. The Project Director to organise regular meetings with the SLFs and TLFs to coordinate the identification of youth.
- Regular reviews with the staff to complete the targets by the due date.

Apart from the training centres established in the ULBs, you are directed to identify and send candidates for the following organisations immediately:

- 1. ICICI Foundation
- 2. Hetero LABs
- 3. Durgasoft Pvt.Ltd

Out of the above mentioned 3 organisations, we are providing hostel facility for ICICI foundation and for rest of the two; the candidates have to stay on their own. The list of courses attached for your reference.


