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I invite your attention to the references cited. Government of Telangana has planned to implement the 6<sup>th</sup> round of National De worming Day Programme on 08.08.2019 and Mop -up Day on 16.08.2019. The government of India has scheduled the bi- annual NDD rounds for every year 10<sup>th</sup> February and 10<sup>th</sup> August in which children in all Junior colleges, Schools and Aanganwadi centers shall be De wormed.

Soil Transmitted Helminthes (STH) also called parasite worms' area significant public health concern of India. Evidence shows detrimental impact of STH infestation on physical growth anemia under nutrition and cognitive development as well as poor attendance at school.

India has the highest burden of soil-transmitted helminths--parasitic worms--in the world. Parasitic worms in children interfere with nutrient uptake, and can contribute to <u>anemia</u>, <u>malnourishment</u>, and impaired mental and physical development.

The prevalence of STH infections is high at 60%. It is crucial for the NDD Programme to reach all children aged 1-19 years consistently in each NDD round. The previous round of NDD conducted on 9.02.2019 showed increased coverage to 96, 09,031 children (97.59%).

The **NDD program** is a national **program** at scale that continues to reach crores of children and adolescents with deworming benefits through a safe medicine Albendazole. (Tablet)

The objective of National Deworming Day is to deworm all preschool and schoolage children (enrolled and non-enrolled) between the ages of 1-19 years through the platform of schools and Anganwadi Centers, in order to improve their overall health, nutritional status, access to education and quality of life.

To prepare for National Deworming Day, teachers and anganwadi workers have been trained to administer the tablet to children, while ASHAs and other functionaries will generate awareness and mobilize children to be deformed on the day.

**Venue for Administration of the tablet**: Schools Private and Government Schools, Anganwadi centers, Intermediate colleges and polytechnic colleges.

Target Group: 1-19 years (covering Adolescent Age group)

In this regard following activities to be monitor by the MEPMA field staff

- SHG, SLF and TLF/TVS meetings in the month of July 2019 -H discussed on coverage of children of 1-19 years for NDD programme as Health Agenda, documented in the SLF and TLF meeting minute's books.
- Orientation to all the SLF Presidents and RPs on NDD by concern DMCs and TMCs by July 2<sup>nd</sup> week.
- To conduct the rallies with SHG members, ASHA and anganwadi workers .
- To identify Drop out school children and also identify the places where Anganwadi and Schools are not available near by slum areas

- Submit the Ward wise progress report on mobilization of children by COs in the Files Nioe MEPMA-NUHM/UF/1/2017-SMC-SMID-MEPMA-Part(14)
- Coverage the shelter residents of age group 1to 19 years, ESTP training centers with students 18 to 19 years students
- Awareness to Mothers of SHG women of Children age group 1 to 19 years and facilitate for mobilization for NDD program.

Hence the Additional Commissioner UCD GHMC all the Project Directors MEPMA and UCD GHMC to support the 6th round of NDD for comprehensive outreach to all children in the State, through active participation of the SHGs in all ULBs of 33 districts by promoting Health agenda in importance of NDD and communicate the dates of NDD on 08.08.2019 and Mop –up Day on 16.08.2019 in all SLF and TLF meetings and facilitate the children for NDD and submit the report on NDD in prescribed format to this office
