

Sub:- DAY-NULM - MEPMA - SUH - Telangana -Suggestions to explore the possibility of using old and condemned Railway Passenger Coaches as Shelters for needy and homeless- feasibility and no. of coaches required-information called for- Regarding

1) No. K-12/20/2017-UPA II Section (EFS3021581), Dated: /09/2017 of the Director (UPA-I), MoHUPA (UPA Division), Govt. of India.

2) Action Plan for Shelter for Urban Homeless for the year 2017-18.

Kindly peruse the reference 1st cited wherein the Director (UPA-I), MoHUPA, Government of India has communicated the suggestion of the Hon'ble Minister for Railways, GoI, who has suggested that condemned Railway passenger coaches may be used as shelters for needy and homeless after arranging connections to water supply sewerage lines. Railways have offered the condemned coaches on 'as is where is' basis and the coaches can be moved by the concerned organizations to the places where the shelters are to proposed to be operationalized.

Shelter for urban homeless are to be set up at main centers of cities, including Railway stations, but majority of the ULBs are finding it difficult to locate land for constructing the shelters near the main centers. It is, therefore, requested that till the permanent shelters are established by ULBs as per guidelines of DAY-NULM, the possibility of using old and condemned Railway passenger coaches as shelters for urban poor may be explored so that the requisite number of shelters can be setup quickly at places where the shelters are actually required. While, exploring the feasibility the issues such as approach way to shelter, disposal of waste, availability of water, and other facilities may also be looked into. The cost of refurbishment of these coaches can be met from DAY-NULM funds with the approval of Project Sanctioning Committee. If feasible, the number of coaches required may be indicated so as to enable us to communicate the same to the Railway Authorities and MoHUPA for further necessary action.

Further, as per the action plan submitted by the ULBs vide reference 2nd cited, the target for establishment of New Shelters during 2017-18 is as follows:

undersigned is directed to enclose herewith a copy of D.O No.2017/M(C)/203/1/72 dated 11th August, 2017 received from Honorable Minister of Railways on the subject mentioned above.

- 2. The Hon'ble Minister has suggested that condemned Railway passenger coaches may be used as shelters for needy and homeless after arranging connections to water supply sewerage lines. Railways have offered the condemned coaches on 'as is where is' basis and the coaches can be moved by the concerned organizations to the places where the shelters are to proposed to be operationalized.
- 3. Shelter for urban homeless is required to be set up at main centres of cities including like Railway stations, but majority of the Urban Local Bodies are finding it difficult to locate land for constructing the shelters near the main centres. It is, therefore, requested that till the permanent shelters are established by states/ ULBs as per guidelines of DAY-NULM, the possibility of using old and condemned Railway passenger coaches as shelters for urban poor may please be explored so that the requisite number of shelters can be set up quickly at places where the shelters are actually required. While exploring the feasibility the issues such as approach way to shelter, disposal of waste, availability of water and other facilities may also be looked into. The cost of refurbishment of these coaches can be met from DAY-NULM funds with the approval of respective PSCs. If feasible, the number of coaches required may be indicated so as to enable this Ministry to communicate the same to the Railway authorities for further necessary action.

The Director (UPA-1), Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs has informed the Hon'ble Minister for Railways has suggested that condemned Railway Passenger Coaches may be used as shelters for needy and homeless after arranging connections to water supply and sewerage lines. He has also informed that majority of Urban Local Bodies (ULBs) are finding it difficult to locate land for constructing the shelters near the main centres like railway stations and requested to explore the possibility of using old and condemned railway passenger coaches as shelters for urban poor so that requisite number of shelters can be set-up at places where the shelters are actually required. He has informed that the cost of the refurbishment of these coaches can be met from the DAY-NULM. The Ministry has requested to indicate the numbers of coaches required for using the condemned railway passenger coaches as shelters.

The M.D, MEPMA is therefore requested to critically examine the suggestion made by the Ministry of Railways and Housing & Urban Affairs and intimate the numbers of coaches required for the purpose to Government so as to furnish the same to Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs, Government of India.

Dear Shri Tomar Ji,



While reviewing the flood situation in Assam in a meeting with my colleague Shri Rajen Gohain, a suggestion to explore the possibility of using old and condemned Railway passenger coaches as shelters for needy and homeless was made. I found it to be a good one as these coaches come with basic facilities like berths for sleeping and toilets. Once connections to a source of water and sewer lines are arranged they will be ready for use as shelters. They can be put to use whenever required and can also be moved from one place to another, etc. in case of emergencies like floods and other natural calamities. The condemned coaches will be offered by Railways on 'as is where is' basis and Ministry of Urban Development will have to arrange to move these to the desired locations. Some refurbishment would also be required to be carried out before putting them to use.

I would request you to consider the possibility of using old, condemned Railway coaches for the purpose of shelters.
