Minutes of the Meeting with the Auto Drivers Associations held on 16-03-2013 MEPMA Office

Present: Smt. Anita Ramachandran, I.A.S., Mission Director, MEPMA

At the outset Mission Director, MEPMA has informed to the Presidents and Secretaries of Auto Drivers associations that the MEPMA is working for Elimination of Poverty in urban areas It is noticed that the families of Auto drivers are facing lot of problems and MEPMA has Convened a meeting with a view to understand their issues in order to see if they can be benefited from the ongoing Govt schemes.

The representatives of Auto Drivers Association were given opportunity to express their problems and the following are the major issues expressed by them.

- 1. There are 2.00 Lakhs autos approximately in Twin Cities.
- 2. There is no Insurance coverage available for Auto Drivers.
- 3. The Bank Loan Facilities are not available.
- 4. Subsidy of 35% to be provided on purchase of Auto through Bank Loan.
- Auto Drivers Welfare Board to be established on the lines of Labour Welfare Board.
- 6. 1% cess to be collected from Oil Companies, Tyre industry and create a welfare fund
- 7. Driving Licence and renewal is being done with out Minimum Qualification at Tamilnadu, West Bengal, Delhi and Kerala.
- 8. Some states extending financial support for Girls marriage to the tune of Rs.25, 000/-.
- 9. Three wheeler and four wheeler Licence to be provided by making one day exclusively for Auto Drivers.
- 10. To earmark a area in the city for Auto Drivers Housing Colony
- 11. Auto Licence to be the Surety for Bank Loan.
- 12. The Hiring Autos to be reduced.
- 13. Harassment from Traffic Police to be minimised.
- 14. Parking Slots at Major Junctions to be marked by GHMC.
- 15. Separate package for Education of their children and Scholarships to be arranged.
- 16. Self Employment and Skill Trainings to be provided.
- 17. Minimum qualification of 8 th class for Driving Licence to be removed.
- 18. ESI and PF facilities to be extended.

The above issues are related to various departments, the co-ordination with all the relevant departments is required to address these issues.

The Following are the decision taken.

- The Profiling of families of auto Drivers in a Format to be collected with the help of associations by 10 th of April 2013.
- The GHMC Livelihood wing will co-ordinate.
- The Verification will be done through COs by 20 th of April 2013.
- Banking Specialist will prepare proposal to be placed in SLBC
- The special Project for Auto Drivers can be paid under SJSRY special Projects to get the funds from GOI
- Insurance package will be designed by the insurance specialists.
