I invite your attention to the references cited wherein it has been instructed all the PDs of MEPMA to facilitate stitching of Uniforms of Boarders of BC Welfare Hostels as per the timelines communicated.

In this regard all the PDs are requested to note the following instructions:

1. The request made by the Project Directors in the video conference on 29-05-2013 to permit the SHG Women to stitch the uniforms for the boarders of the BC Welfare hostels has been discussed with the Commissioner, BC welfare and it was not considered due to the reasons mentioned earlier. So you are requested to prepare the wife SHG women interested to stitch the uniforms to complete the task at the hostel points of BC Welfare department as directed in the previous circular.

- 2. Identification of the SHG women who are willing to stitch the uniforms at the hostel points and matching and batching should be done within two days and submit the details in the prescribed format by 4th June, 2013.
- 3. The transportation cost for moving the sewing machines to and from the hostel points should not exceed Rs.1000/- per hostel (100 boarders and 5 machines) and if lesser number of machines required the cost should be given on pro rata basis.
- 4. The cost for the threads and buttons to the SHG women may be given @, Rs.2/- per
- 5. You are requested to submit the details of SHG women attached to each hostel along with their names and contact numbers by 4th June, 2013.
- 6. Travel allowance to the SHG Women may be given an based on actual rates.
