"Telangana ku Haritha Haaram (THH)", a flagship programme of the State Government envisages increasing the tree cover of the State. The strategy developed to achieve the above objective is undertaking massive plantation programme in every possible open space outside the forest and take up intensive rejuvenation and regeneration works coupled with soil and moisture conservation in the degraded forest areas throughout the State.

In this programme planting drive in the entire State will be taken up in 2nd week of July. People from all walks of life, Government agencies, officers, prominent citizens, and public representatives, CBOs will participate in this programme

Accordingly in this financial year 2018-19 , it is decided to participate active role from Community Based Organizations (CBOs) in all ULBs under supervision of concern Municipal Commissioner by involving all Self Help Groups (SHGs) in commercial nurseries & Homestead Nurseries .

The objective

- To involve women from the slums in raising and maintenance of nurseries
- To enable the urban women to get additional income
- To facilitate the livelihood for unemployed poor women
- To establish nurseries for variety of local species with emphasis on shade, flowering and medicinal plants
- To increase the environmental awareness

Technical assistance will be given to procure soil mixture, poly bags, seeds and fertilizers. The Women will undertake the job of nursery raising and maintenance for a period of 4 to 6 months within their back yard or common site in the locality.

Commercial Nurseries: Selection of two Active SHG women for Haritaharam 2 per ULB for 50 saplings and 4 per Municipal Corporations for one Lakh saplings for taking care in raising nurseries like watering, changing covers, pruning etc. And Rs 4500 /- per month will be paid care takers of these SHG women for six months

Eligibility for selection of care takers of nurseries

- Senior in SHG women
- SLF resolution
- Knowledge in nursery (gardening)
- Poor BPL women for livelihood purpose

Hence all the Project Directors are instructed to depute selected active caretaker of SHG women 2 per ULB and 4 per Municipal Corporations for one day work shop on training programme on Nurseries under Telangana Ku Haritha Haaram (THH) programme on Date 2.05.2018 at 10.A.M Conference Hall, CDMA Hyderabad.
