2. MOU agreement NUHM &MEPMA Dated 26.11.2020



I invite attention to the subject & references cited. The Commissioner Health & Family Welfare, MD NHM Telangana has issued instructions to utilize the services of Resource persons (RPs) of MEPMA for doing House hold survey on Non Communicable Diseases(NCD) followed by screening at BasthiDawakhana & UPHC in Urban Areas .

2. It is also mention that in Telangana State epidemiological transition has happened from Communicable Diseases to Non Communicable Diseases. Non Communicable Diseases account for 65% of state's diseases. In order to minimize the disease burden the Department of Health in the last 3 year has been conducting universal screening of population for the (Hypertension, Diabetes). After screening is done the patients are also given regular medicine.

3 Telangana has been one the foremost states in the country in controlling the hypertension and diabetics.

4 This year, Health department has initiated universal screening for 10 diseases (Hypertension, Diabetes, Oral Cancer, Breast Cancer, Cervical Cancer, Kidney, Heart, Mental Health, TB and Leprosy) Household survey is done by ASHA's and ANM's followed by confirmation by Medical Officer CHC/Area Hospital.(APP Based survey) Comprehensive Disease care pathways have been worked out and concerned doctors and specialist having been trained.

5 So far house hold survey for 1.3 Crores population has been completed. While there is good progress in rural areas, in urban areas it is proposed to utilize the services of the Resource persons for doing house hold survey followed by screening at Bastidawakhana & UPHCs in urban areas in coordination with Health Dept. Meanwhile it is directed to map the SLFs with near by Bastidawakhana & UPHCs .

6 Hence, the Additional Commissioner GHMC and all the Project Directors of MEPMA are hereby requested to utilize the services of Resource Persons (RPs) of MEPMA for above mentioned purpose. And further trainings to RPs on NCD APP will be facilitated by the Health Department in all the ULBs.
